

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TRAIL REROUTE Reference: Map 10, Kitchener, Edition 7.0 <> Black Walnut Section effective April 2016



REVISED WORDING for the back of Map 10, Edition 7.0

... After the last house the trail turns left passing between houses out to Edgewater Cres. It turns right along the sidewalk a short distance and past a private street. Just before 264 Edgewater Cres it veers right for a few metres along a groomed path/sidewalk. At approximately km 34.0 (coordinates 43.443353, -80.405933) the trail no longer enters a woodlot. The trail turns left along a multipurpose, stonedust trail and proceeds for about 400 m before veering right and across Idlewood Creek on a steel bridge. After crossing the bridge the trail veers right following the creek (on the right) for about 700 m and arriving at Woolner Trail (formerly Zeller Drive) [formerly km 34.4]. Turning right, the trail descends to the end of Woolner Trail at the Grand River, where it turns left onto a crushed stone trail, which is part of the Walter Bean Grand River Trail (WBGRT). About 50 m along the crushed stone path, the GVT veers right along a footpath in a wooded area closer to the river. ...

This reroute alone adds approximately 0.7 km to the main trail. The old km 34.4 becomes km 35.1.
