Position Description:

You are supported by an available work parties and construction crew, and you work under the guidance and training of a Trail Maintenance Director. Seasonal reports are required. An ideal project for a young family.

Specialized Training:

Training is provided by the Trail Maintenance Director for your trail division.

Time Commitment:

Several days a year, in all seasons for at least one year..

An individual, family, or organized group.

Towpath, Carolinian Crest, Black Walnut, Pinnacle

A vehicle is not essential but would be useful.
