Position Title: Trail Maintenance Volunteers

Position Description:

As part of a work party, Trail Maintenance Volunteers do light maintenance (trail blazing, weed whacking, brush cutting, and trash pickup) or help with construction projects. You are supervised and supported by a trail director, experienced trail volunteers, and construction crew. An ideal activity for individuals, a family, service club, corporate group, or highschool class. From time to time, “all-women” crews go out for a fun half-day of work on the trail.

Specialized Training:

Training is provided by the Trail Maintenance Director and Trail Captains for your trail division.

Time Commitment:

One or more days a year.
